P.R.E. RULES TO COMPETE

THESE CLASSES ARE OPEN TO HORSES THAT ARE REGISTERED WITH IALHA (OR REGISTRATION PENDING) WHOSE LINEAGE CAN BE DOCUMENTED TO TRACE BACK COMPLETELY TO THE SPANISH STUDBOOK IN BOTH THE DAM AND SIRE LINES. ONLY HORSES WITH "S" AFTER THE REGISTRATION NUMBERS ON IALHA PAPERS OR OTHER COUNTRY REGISTRATION PAPERS (Ex. CARTA) SHOWING TRUE SPANISH LINEAGE WILL BE ALLOWED TO COMPETE IN THE P.R.E. DIVISION. THE PATTERN USED WHEN SHOWING IN HAND WILL BE AT THE DISCRETION OF THE JUDGE.

Horses 4 years of age and older, except for geldings and cobras, will be required to canter in the ring. Stallions 4 years of age and older must compete in the Functionality Test for their In-Hand scores to be counted.

IN-HAND CLASSES: In-Hand Classes are halter classes for the age groups shown. Horses may be shown in any suitable halter with a throat latch; Spanish tack is not a requisite. Handlers are to be dressed neatly and cleanly (no blue jeans, t-shirts, tennis shoes). Spanish attire for the handler is not a requisite. One handler may handle more than one horse; the stand-in handler accepting the horse in the ring must also be neatly and cleanly dressed (no blue jeans, t-shirts, tennis shoes). Tailers are permitted; there is to be no snapping of a whip held by a tailer.

MORFOLOGÍA CLASSES: Morfología classes are In-Hand Halter Classes, having the same standards, specifications and requirements as in the In-Hand classes mentioned previously. To participate in these classes, the horse must be inscribed and revised (and not failed) and included in the Spanish Stud Book. In addition to the placing in the class, a best movement winner will be selected in each section. That winner is eligible to compete in the appropriate Best Movement Class. A copy of the Spanish paper must be submitted with the entry. If you have not received your "apto" designation, you must present a copy of your Carta de inscripción and acknowledgment of the approval of your horse to compete.

FUNCTIONALITY: This class represents 25% of the Morfología score of stallions 4 years and over. Stallions must participate in this test under saddle to receive a ribbon in the class. Copies of these tests are available at (www.prehorse.org) or by calling Nancy Nathanson at (805)688.8014. The rider for the Functionality Test may be different from the handler in the Morfología Class. Acceptable attire and tack: Traditional Spanish Vaquero with traje corto or Dressage (except no shadbelly). Rides will be scheduled by Show Management, and will be run on Thursday afternoon. Please check with the Show Office.

CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES: Ribbons to Champion and Reserve. These classes are open only to those horses that placed first or second in the Morfologia Classes (ages 4 and over). Horses will return to the ring by sex to compete for the title of Campeona de Campeones (Female Champion of the Breed) and/or Campeon de Campeones (Male Champion of the Breed). The second place horses will line up behind the first place horses. The Champion horse will be chosen from amongst the first place winners. The Reserve Champion will be selected from the remaining first place horses and the second place horse which stood behind the first place winner selected as Champion. No fee charged for these classes.

BEST MOVEMENT CLASSES: Ribbon only to Champion. No other placings will be announced. Horses are not required to return to the ring to compete in order to keep their placing in their age classes.

RIBBONS, AWARDS AND TROPHIES: Ribbons will be given to First through Fifth place. First Place will receive an Award as well. Best Movement awards will be given in In-Hand / Morphology classes, except for stallions 4 years and older, who are required to compete in the Functionality Tests.

CAMPEÒN DE LA RAZA (CHAMPION STALLION OF THE BREED): Awarded to the stallion that best represents the racial characteristics of the breed. Chosen from the stallions that were first in the classes for Stallions 4, 5 & 6, and 7 & over.

SUBCAMPEÒN DE LA RAZA (RESERVE CHAMPION STALLION OF THE BREED): Awarded to the stallion that best represents the racial characteristics of the breed, chosen from the two remaining stallions in the ring after the Campeòn/Champion has been selected.

CAMPEONA DE LA RAZA (CHAMPION MARE OF THE BREED): Awarded to the mare that best represents the racial characteristics of the breed. Chosen from the mares that were first in the classes for Mares 4, 5 & 6, and 7 and over.

SUBCAMPEONA DE LA RAZA (RESERVE CHAMPION MARE OF THE BREED): Awarded to the mare that best represents the racial characteristics of the breed. Chosen from the two remaining mares in the ring after the Campeona/Champion Mare has been chosen.

CAMPEÒN/SUBCAMPEÒN DE FUNCIONALIDAD (CHAMPION AND RESERVE CHAMPION OF FUNCTIONALITY): Chosen from the two highest scores in the Functionality Test for stallions in the classes for Stallions 4, 5 & 6, and 7 & over.

PREMIOS A LOS MEJORES MOVIMIENTOS (BEST MOVEMENT): This prize is offered to the horse in each section (except the stallions competing in Functionality) with the highest score for the walk and trot combined. The winner from each class may choose to enter the competition for Mejores Movimientos (Best Movement). Best Movement Champions then compete amongst themselves for the title.
